### ITINERARY

**DAY 1 THURSDAY (LD) Cairns, Cape Tribulation , Cooktown Area.** Early morning pick up from your Cairns accommodation. Through the pristine Daintree Rainforests and over the soaring verdant heights of the Bloomfield Track to Cooktown.

**DAY 2 FRIDAY (BD) Lakefield National Park.** A morning of sightseeing and viewing significant landmarks and sites so important to all Australians. Via the rugged Battlecamp Range, pioneer cattle stations and the old coach road to arrive at the massive wildlife haven, Lakefield National Park.

**DAY 3 SATURDAY (BLD) Musgrave, Coen, Archer River.** Historic interludes as we visit Musgrave, the last remaining Telegraph Station in Cape York, and the once vibrant gold rush town of Coen, before reaching our overnight stop at the Archer River.

**DAY 4 SUNDAY (BLD) Iron Range National Park.** Cross the Wenlock and Pascoe Rivers before entering Iron Range National Park. The park features the largest area of tropical lowland rainforest remaining in Australia. Home to many rare fauna and flora. There is also impressive coastal and mountain range scenery. Overnight camp for 2 nights.

**DAY 5 MONDAY (BLD) Portland Roads, Chillli Beach, WW2 Sites.** An exciting day visiting significant historical sites and breathtaking scenery. Portland Roads, once a vital sea port for miners and the wartime airfields. Chillli Beach is wide and long and fringed with palms. A magical spot overlooking Restoration Island, Bligh's landing site in 1792.

**DAY 6 TUESDAY (BLD) Batavia Goldfields, Weipa.** Travel West to visit the old Batavia (Wenlock) Gold Fields, an abandoned mining town. Then travel North by West across Piccaninny Plains and boundless savannah to Weipa, on the Gulf of Carpentaria. A veritable "Oasis in the Wilderness" and providing further contrast to your experience of this last frontier.

**DAY 7 WEDNESDAY (BD) Wenlock River, Moreton Station.** In the cool of the early morning, an optional Weipa Mine Tour (own cost, as is lunch). With the Gulf of Carpentaria behind us, we pass through huge cattle runs to arrive at the fast flowing Wenlock River, for our overnight camp at Moreton Telegraph Station.

**DAY 8 THURSDAY (BLD) Telegraph Road, Twin Falls.** A really challenging route today as we ford fast flowing streams and traverse rugged 4WD tracks to overnight at the idyllic Twin Falls. Basic facilities.

**DAY 9 FRIDAY (BLD) Jardine River, Punsand Bay.** Across the free flowing Jardine, a brief refuelling stop at Bamaga and we drive via Lockerbie to our base camp at Punsand Bay Private Reserve.

**DAY 10 SATURDAY (BD) Thursday Island.** Today time to explore Thursday Island and Horn Island (own Cost) as is lunch today. Afternoon ferry transfer to Mainland, then onto Punsand Bay.

**DAY 11 SUNDAY (BLD) Cape York, Somerset.** An unforgettable day of achievement and interest. We stand at the very tip of our continent. Visit the ruins of Somerset (road conditions permitting).

**DAY 12 MONDAY (BLD) Seisia, Commence Sea-leg. "Barge Day".** The focus of all attention today is Seisia wharf, as the cargo ships from Cairns disgorge their cargo of fuel, building materials, indeed everything needed by the local communities. At 80 meters and over 3000 tonnes the Trinity Bay is the largest cargo vessel, servicing the Torres Strait communities.

**DAY 13 TUESDAY (BLD) Great Barrier Reef Marine Park.** Total relaxation as you enjoy the company of the crew and new ship board companions.

**DAY 14 WEDNESDAY (B) Disembark Cairns.** On arrival at Trinity Wharf your tour concludes when we return you to your pre-arranged accommodation.

You will visit the oldest rainforest in the world, some of Queensland's largest and most diverse National Parks, you will also visit the rich mining area where the red bauxite mineral has painted the earth a rich & deep red.

Included is a visit to Australia's largest tropical lowland rainforest, home to rare flora, fauna and remnants of rich cultural, mining and wartime history. Traverse rugged telegraph tracks, swim in pristine rivers & streams, and wash away the stress of city living in clear cool waterfalls.

Relax every evening around an open campfire, enjoying good wholesome food and new companions; sleep under the stars each night all the while receiving informative interpretation by our dedicated professional tour guides.

Revel in the achievement of reaching Australia's most northerly point, Cape York. Included in your camping tour is a visit to Thursday & Horn Islands, The Torres Strait another unique, picturesque, remarkable place to visit and soak up the culture and see first hand the Island way of life and learn about the diverse war time history of these magnificent islands.

This is truly living the spirit of adventure in a reasonable degree of comfort in our purpose built 4WD drive air conditioned vehicles we pick you up and drop you back to your accommodation and all in between is an

An important element is group participation. Whether striking camp, a fireside chat or an early morning bush walk. We favor traditional open fire and camp oven cooking and careful planning ensures fresh sourced food along the way delivers hearty healthy meals throughout the tour.

Your Holiday home is a roomy, twin share, high profile Dome Tents, with sewn in floor and High density foam mattresses.

The friendly rivalry begins after a day or two as the trials begin for poll position in the "Sport of Campers" tent erecting.

Shower and toilet facilities are available at National Park camping areas, or camp ground locations.

Some passengers prefer to substitute a shower for a swim in the fresh water creeks or rivers, (as directed by your guide) when available.

Our 4WD safaris and tours visit isolated outback and undisturbed areas, normally inaccessible to large multi-seat coaches, and due to the remoteness of these regions, conditions will not be exactly the same as at home.

Your companions will be from every walk of life, of all ages and usually with a spirit of adventure, a sense of humour, and a desire to get off the beaten track to enjoy the wilderness, to discover the real Australia.

## ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Oz Tours Safaris is dedicated to the care and preservation of Cape York Peninsula and Gulf Savannah, the surrounding waters, reefs and islands. Our experienced environmentally-conscious staff follow best practices that not only enhance the quality of your experience but protect the environment in which you travel.

## HOW TO BOOK

## DEPOSIT

A deposit of \$300 per person together with completed booking form is required to ensure confirmation. The payment of deposit by and/or on behalf of any person constitutes the full agreement with and the acceptance of the terms and conditions as set forth in this document.

## FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Whilst prices could be subject to change without notice, upon final payment, all tour fares are fixed and not subject to change. For tours departing in less than 45 days, full and immediate payment is required. Fares are shown in Australian currency.

## YOUR TOUR

**What is Included** - Meals, except where otherwise stated in itinerary, boat cruise fares where applicable, tented and any other accommodation on share basis and entrance fees as per itinerary.

**What is not Included** - Accommodation, meals, fares en route from home cities. Meals, unless specifically mentioned on day to day itinerary, sleeping bags, pillows (available for hire) and any personal items such as drinks, newspapers, telephone, laundry, souvenirs and personal holiday insurance. FUEL LEVY MAY APPLY.

## Smoking

As per Government Regulations, smoking is not permitted in vehicles. Ample stops provide time for "smoking breaks" en route.

## Unused Tour Sectors

If a passenger fails to join a tour/safari or joins in after departure, or leaves it prior to completion, no refunds can be made. No refunds will be made in respect of any part of the tour including food, excursions, accommodation, etc., that are not used or undertaken.

## Concession and Child Fares

Children 14 years and under, on all overland camping safaris 15% off adult fare. Children 14 years or under, on all land/sea, land/air camping safaris 10% off adult fares. Child fares accommodated tours on application. Group discounts on application.

## Insurance & Travel

Oz Tours and/or its agents are not responsible or liable for loss or damage or theft of luggage or personal belongings whatsoever or for personal injury, accidents, hospitalisation, illness or medical expenses. Most claims arise from personal or close-family illness before holiday departure, resulting in cancellation charges. ## Cancellation Fees

Bookings cancelled 45 days or more prior to tour departure date will receive a full refund. Cancellations between: 44-29 days prior to tour 25% of fare forfeited. Between 28-14 days prior to tour 50% of fare forfeited. Less than 14 days prior to tour 100% of fare forfeited.

## YOUR VEHICLE

Our modern, air conditioned Toyota, Mitsubishi Canter, Man Larc or Isuzu safari vehicles are all equipped with standard features, such as forward facing seats, P.A. system and Sat phones, comprehensive first aid kit and all the necessary off road equipment you can think of (and then some).

Single vehicle or combinations of vehicles from Oz Tours Safaris fleet provide tour group sizes ranging from a minimum of 4 passengers up to a possible maximum of 22 passengers. On all tours, passengers rotate seats and vehicles each day to give everyone a chance to enjoy forward and window seating, the different vehicles and Oz Tours Safari Team Members during the tour.

## YOUR SHIP

The MV "Trinity Bay" built in 1996 and converted in 1998 is an eighty metre passenger carrying cargo vessel that has accommodation for up to 56 passengers and cruises at the speed of 14 knots. The vessel travels from Cairns through the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park on a non-stop voyage to and from the ports of Thursday Island and Sesia All meals are provided as buffet style and coffee & tea facilities are provided all day and there is also a licensed bar on board.

The MV Trinity Bay reserves the right to deny boarding of any persons with a medical condition or disability which could limit their mobility or which could be exacerbated in rough weather.

## YOUR AIRCRAFT

**Qantaslink.** Air-leg is Cairns to Horn Island. Your aircraft is a 50 seater Dash 8 with in flight facilities. Cruise speed is approximately 520 km/hr and cruising at 21,000 feet. A light refreshment is provided. Please be aware of the volume and weight restrictions, as Qantas have a ONE piece per person check in luggage policy. Please check with our office if unsure. A8A0/C10A0/C7A0/C70A.

**Skytrans.** Air leg is from Bamaga to Cairns. Aircraft is a 36 seater De Havilland Canada Dash 8 -100 series. Cruise speed is 435km/h, altitude 25,000 feet. Pressurised cabin.

## ALCOHOL RESTRICTIONS - HOW WILL IT AFFECT YOU?

Alcohol restrictions are currently in place in some of the Indigenous communities we visit. These restrictions may only affect part of your tour, depending which tour you are doing with Oz Tours Safaris.

In 2004 Queensland Parliament passed a Bill which improves enforcement of liquor laws in restricted areas but also minimises its potential impact on the tourism industry. Strict conditions apply for any permits granted to tour operators by the Liquor Licensing Division. Such permits specify the dates, type and amount of alcohol allowed in a tour vehicle while in a restricted area.

We ask that you contact Oz Tours Safaris reservations on 1800 079 006 prior to commencing your tour for information about alcohol restrictions that may be applicable to part of your tour.
