

FIT-TO-TRAVEL CLEARANCE REQUEST

Dear Doctor,

Your patient wishes to travel on one of Sea Swift's industrial vessels. This passenger carrying cargo vessel operates out of Cairns and sails to the tip of Cape York (5-night round trip).

The vessel travels to remote area and enroute medical assistance may be up to a day away. The vessel is first and foremost a working cargo vessel and is bound by strict health and safety regulations. It should not be compared to a dedicated passenger cruise liner. Whilst it is more than comfortable for passengers it is not a five-star ship. There is no doctor on board.

We need to verify that your patient is suitable for travel on our vessel without undue risk. The vessel contains potential hazards, such as: steep staircases, high hatch-way step-overs, gangway access, cramped bathrooms, as well as the general movement of a vessel at sea.

Based on the criteria below, please either use the spaces to enter your determination or provide correspondence on letterhead dated and signed with your credentials.

- Passengers must be independently mobile and steady on their feet. To ensure their own safety and the safety of others, they must be able to climb 2 flights of steep staircases unaided and with reasonable confidence.
- Passengers must be mentally alert to cope with the confusion of an active workplace and a possible emergency situation. This has never happened to date but we need to plan for the worst case scenario.
- Passengers must have adequate vision to cope with the industrial nature of the ship.
- Due to the remote location, passengers must not have any health concerns where they will be at risk unless the condition is adequately controlled by medication which they are able to bring with them and administer themselves.
